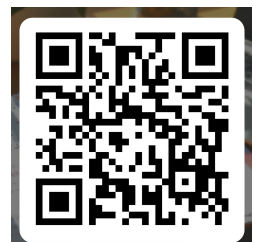


Sound Horses & Confirmation Networking Session
