

What is a NCCP Instructor/Coach Cohort? A virtual training, mentoring, and certification opportunity for Instructor or Competition Coach candidates or professional development for coaches.

When and how? This cohort will kick off on January 20th, 2026, and will work together for 10 sessions until Spring. The sessions will be held via Zoom. All sessions in the cohort begin at 7:00pm Atlantic, and session lengths vary. See the schedule below for course dates and times. The full cohort is encouraged, but we will have other registration options.

What happens after? At the conclusion of the cohort, candidates will be assessed and given an action plan to continue training or complete certification. Cohort participants can participate in training without their coaching pre-requisites but the requirements must be met before moving forward to evaluation. Candidates who successfully demonstrate preparedness for evaluation may choose to complete their evaluation with the cohort evaluators for an additional reduced evaluation fee. This will occur in May to December.

Why the cohort approach?

The cohorts have been developed to address several issues candidates commonly face:

- 1) Evaluation Prep – Without a mentor, access to training and clear instructions of what is expected, evaluations can be very stressful for candidates. The cohort provides built in mentors and clear information on the current program requirements.
- 2) Cost – Coach certification can be expensive for candidates! Candidates need a better solution so we have provided an opportunity with mentoring, training, and an optional cost-effective evaluation opportunity to reduce costs (i.e. reduced travel costs, better preparation for the evaluation, more frequent shorter training times to allow a coach to work around their coaching and other life situations and avoid given up a full day of coaching or life, etc.)
- 3) Inefficient Process – Without the cohort support, candidates can feel overwhelmed and take longer to complete requirements because they are working through it without support and deadlines. The cohort provides clear resources, a step-by-step process and support.
- 4) Location – It can be difficult for coaches to travel to mentors, training, and evaluations so the cohort can reduce that allowing candidates to work in their home areas.

Registration Options:

We encourage participants to sign up for the full cohort, which is also the best value. However, we do recognize that sometimes there are reasons that individuals may not be able to do the full cohort. We do offer some registrations alternatives.

Full Cohort - This includes learning sessions, NCCP Equestrian Theory Modules, Lesson Review, and if eligible, an opportunity to sign up (fee required) for a video evaluation through the cohort (some restrictions do apply).

Theory Modules Only - These six sessions will cover the following modules: NCCP Long-Term Equestrian Development (LTED), NCCP Plan an Equestrian Practice, & NCCP Analyzing Equestrian Performance. These modules can also be signed up individually.
