Submit using the Scotia Series Official Program Foundations Judge Mentoring Form (minimum 2). Mentoring must be done with a Scotia Series recognized judge or a current Equestrian Canada official. Other mentors may be approved upon request to Equestrian NS. The mentoring forms can come from combination of: Equestrian NS approved judging clinics, shadow judging, and individual mentoring at competition.

- Judging Experience – Submit resume of your judging experience from the past 5 years (more can be included, if desired). Please include dates, competitions, classes, hours, and any additional judging clinics. Minimum of 5 competitions in the last 5 years*.
